DIRECT CREMATION \$ 1395 to \$ 1910
The charge for a direct cremation includes removal of remains, local transportation to
crematory, necessary authorizations, basic services of staff and overhead expenses. This
charge does not include the crematory fee or the use of facilities and staff for any
visitation or ceremony, public or private, prior to the cremation. If you want to arrange a
direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the
body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or
without an outside covering). The containers we provide are fiberboard boxes.
