TO THOSE WE ARE PRIVILEGED TO SERVE:

It is our goal to make sure that your family is served with the utmost of care, compassion and professionalism. We want to provide your family with the knowledge and understanding to make the best decisions for your loved one's services. Please feel free to address any questions or concerns that you may have regarding the costs or services. We are here to ease your mind and to assure you and your family of the services that you deserve.

Prior to drafting any contract for goods and services, the responsible party or the decedent's survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any preneed agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent.

Please note that there may be charges for items selected by you that are not described in this price list.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any item you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

- **Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff**

\$720

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, cremation with memorial service, immediate burial and forwarding or receiving remains. (Non-Declinable)

This is a basic fee that we charge every family for our professional expertise in assisting them with their preferences and are the basic services, not to be included in prices of other categories in the General Price List that are furnished by a funeral provider in arranging

any funeral, such as consultation with the family, administrative and clerical services, obtaining necessary permits, consultation with the clergy, cemetery, crematory or common carrier, planning the funeral or memorial services and placement of necessary newspaper obituary notices. There will be a charge for each service requested or required.

- **Local Transfer of the Deceased to the Mortuary** (Within a 50-mile radius) \$395
(Additional charge for 2nd man residential removal) \$100
- **Obtaining a valid Death Certificate** \$125
- **Obtaining a valid Fetal Death Certificate** (Within a 30 mile radius) \$75
- **1 Hour In-Person Consultation** \$100

- **Embalming** \$325

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Burial Packages

Traditional Chapel/Church Service.....**\$3495**

Basic services of funeral director and staff, local transfer of deceased to mortuary, processing of Death Certificate, embalming, other preparation of body, hearse, flower vehicle, use of facilities and staff for evening visitation, use of facilities and staff for funeral ceremony, use of equipment and staff for graveside service.

Traditional Graveside Service.....**\$3100**

Basic services of funeral director and staff, local transfer of deceased to mortuary, processing of Death Certificate, embalming, other preparation of body, hearse, flower vehicle, use of facilities and staff for evening visitation, use of equipment and staff for graveside service.

1-Hour View/Graveside..... **\$2880**

Basic services of funeral director and staff, local transfer of deceased to mortuary, 1-Hour Viewing, processing of Death Certificate, embalming, other preparation of the body, hearse, flower vehicle and use of facilities and staff for graveside service.

Simplistic Graveside.....**\$2605**

Basic services of funeral director and staff, local transfer of deceased to mortuary, processing of Death Certificate, temporary refrigeration, preparation of un-embalmed remains, hearse, flower vehicle and use of equipment and staff for graveside services.

Cremation Packages

Traditional Chapel/Church Cremation with Service.....**\$2750**

Basic services of funeral director and staff, local transfer of deceased to mortuary, processing of Death Certificate, embalming, crematory fee, other preparation of body, use of facilities and staff for evening visitation, use of facilities and staff for funeral service.

Cremation with Graveside Service.....**\$1640**

Basic services of funeral director and staff, local transfer of deceased to mortuary, processing of Death Certificate, crematory fee, alternative container, use of equipment and staff for graveside service, hearse and flower vehicle.

Cremation with Memorial Service.....\$1090

Basic services of funeral director and staff, local transfer of deceased to mortuary, refrigeration, processing of Death Certificate, crematory fee, alternative container, use of facilities and staff for memorial service.

The above service packages have been designed to simplify your arrangement process. These packages do not include burial caskets, vaults, flowers, memorial products and/or cash advance items. Your counselor will kindly provide all of your options.

Your family may also select services from the itemized section of the General Price List.

(An additional \$100 fee will apply for a 2nd man on residential removals).

- **Direct Cremation** – If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you may use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are alternative containers and other cremation containers, including containers made of wood, containers made of fiberboard and containers made of other composite materials. Our charges for direct cremation (without ceremony) include removal of the remains from the local place of death, processing and filing of Death Certificate, alternative container, refrigeration and basic services of funeral director and staff, transportation to the crematory. The crematory fee is included.

- **Forwarding of Remains to Another Mortuary and / or Funeral Home** \$1395
 This charge includes local removal of the deceased, minimum services of our staff, necessary authorizations, embalming, use of preparation room, processing and filing of Death Certificate, shipping container or combination air tray, and transportation to Ontario Airport

- **Receiving remains from Another Mortuary and / or Funeral Home** \$1195
 This charge includes minimum services of our staff, transportation from Ontario Airport, processing and filing of Permit and transportation of remains to cemetery or crematory.

- **Immediate Burial** \$1495
 Our charges for Immediate Burial (without any rites or ceremonies at the mortuary, graveside or elsewhere) include removal of the remains from the local place of death, refrigeration, processing and filing of Death Certificate and minimum services of the funeral director and staff and transportation to the cemetery (within a 30 mile radius).

- **Delivery of Cremated Remains to Local Cemetery** \$175
 This service is for families that choose not to have any formal services and wish the cremated remains to be delivered to a local cemetery.

- **Delivery of Casketed Remains to Local Cemetery** \$200
 This service is for families that choose not to have any formal services and wish the casketed remains to be delivered to a local cemetery.

- **Insurance Processing** \$300
 ACS will assist in filing insurance claims and at request assign proceeds to pay for funeral services. **The minimum accepted amount of assignment is \$1500.** We reserve the right not to accept an assignment from any insurance company not willing to cooperate and pay proceeds within 30 days from the time of death.
