ii) Human remains kept under refrigeration over 24 hours beyond death shall be maintained at a temperature level between 35 & 40 degrees F. The remains shall be buried, cremated or entombed within 5 hours following removal from refrigeration.

iii) Under normal circumstances, the public should not view an unembalmed body which has been kept in refrigeration longer than 36 hours.
