Professional Services

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff

\$1,195

This charge includes consultation with the family or responsible party; staff and facilities to respond to initial requests for service; coordination service plans with cemetery, crematory and/or other parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased; securing official documents and necessary registrations and sheltering of the deceased. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forward or receiving of remains.)

Embalming \$395

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement which does not require you to pay for it, such as a direct cremation or immediate burial.

Transportation

All transportation charges contained within this list apply to an area with a radius of 30 miles from our location. If we exceed this service area, in addition to the basic vehicle charge that covers 30 of the total miles traveled from our facility, we make an additional charge of \$3 per mile for a staffed service vehicle one way. If an overnight stay is required due to the round trip exceeding 400 miles, or due to no fault of our own, our driver and vehicle cannot safely return the same day, there will be an additional charge of \$295 for overtime, hotel, and meal expenses, in addition to the basic mileage charges.

Receiving A Deceased Person From Another Mortuary

Minimum Delivery to Cemetery

\$1,495

This discounted package includes the basic services of funeral director and staff (discounted to reflect already secured death certificate and disposition permit and reduced involvement of other personnel), transfer to mortuary from airport within a 30 mile radius and the use of funeral hearse or van to a local cemetery. This package presumes no ceremony and no other use of the funeral home and that we may deliver to the cemetery at the time of our choosing. Add to the fee of \$1,495 any additional services selected, such as graveside ceremony, other preparation - dressing, casketing, viewing, visitation and funeral service at chapel or church.

Forwarding A Deceased Person To Another Mortuary

Minimum Transfer \$1,695

This package includes basic services of funeral director and staff, transfer to mortuary from place of death, embalming, use of utility vehicle to local airport within a 30 mile radius (airline or other shipping charges not included). Other items that may apply and could be added to the contract are a combination shipping container \$275 or air tray \$225. Additional mileage fee will be added outside of service area.

Minimum Transfer with Viewing at Funeral Home

\$1,995

Includes everything as above minimum transfer package with a viewing at funeral home Monday - Friday during business hours.

Immediate Burial \$1,695 - \$5,690

This package includes basic services of funeral director and staff, transfer to mortuary from place of death, other preparation of deceased when embalming is declined, refrigeration and utility vehicle to transport to cemetery within a 30 mile radius. No other services or merchandise are provided.

Disinterment

Removing the Deceased From a Grave or Crypt

Includes basic services of funeral director and staff, transfer to mortuary from place of disinterment, and utility vehicle to transport to airport or other cemetery within a 30 mile radius.

All About Cremation

Your Deceased Family Member Never Leaves Our Care

We are among the very few mortuaries to operate our own crematory inside our clean and secured state of the art facility. It is very important to understand that because of this we are in control of your loved one's care from initial contact with us until the cremated remains are returned to you or placed in their final resting place.

We Only Cremate One Person At A Time

It take more effort to ensure that the cremation is handled with care, dignity and the highest of standards. To assure that your loved one is being cared for appropriately, we strictly adhere to the rigid standards in every cremation process. Each person on our cremation and crematory staff is highly trained and certified. They are dedicated to providing dignified cremation services for your loved one and adhere to the cremation Code of Ethics, and all applicable state laws as assurance to you of our commitment to dignity and honesty.

Your Personal Inspection is Encouraged

We are one of the very few crematory facilities that encourage your personal inspection of the cremation process. We offer a comfortable special viewing room located next to our cremation retorts to facilitate those who wish to be present for the start of the cremation process.

Understanding the Cremation Process

Cremation is the process of reducing the body of the deceased to fragments of bone by the way of heat and flame. We prefer to say "cremated remains" rather than "ashes" because we believe that the term "ashes" could be misleading. Our funeral directors and crematory staff can explain the consistency of cremated remains in as much detail as you prefer. If you are considering scattering, we would recommend you ask us to prepare you for what you will see. If the deceased is Jewish, Christian Orthodox, Muslim or Roman Catholic, you may wish to consult you clergy or our staff for guidance in relation to your religious customs and requirements. For example, the Catholic Church strongly advocates for the presence of the whole body or entire cremated remains to be present for the Funeral Mass. The Catholic Church does not accept the scattering or splitting of cremated remains. Our cremation authorization form goes into some more detail in explaining the cremation process, our policies and procedures. You will receive a copy of all such complete forms during your arrangement consultation.

Mailing of Urns

We will package, transport and mail the cremated remains by U.S. Priority Express Mail only (other carriers will not accept cremated remains) anywhere in the United States for \$150 (add the cost of urn). Keepsake urns will be \$95 each (add the cost of the keepsake). To be safe allow at least 3 - 5 business days for Priority Express Mail in the continental United States. Outside the county mailing services starts at \$250.

Cremation Service Options

It will be necessary to select or provide a container for any viewing and/or cremation process as well as a container for the cremated remains. We offer a wide variety of rental and combustible containers for cremation. We also offer a wide variety of distinctive and value priced urns. Because we schedule our crematory days in advance, and due in part to the time involved in meeting the legal requirements of the death certificate and disposition permit, we allow for 3-5 days following the permit being issued to complete the cremation process on average.

Traditional Cremation \$3,275

This service includes basic services of funeral director and staff, transfer to mortuary from place of death, embalming, other preparation, dressing, casketing, cosmetics, viewing 1-4 hours, funeral hearse, funeral ceremony, utility vehicle for death certificates and permits, ceremonial rental casket (wood or metal) and alternative container, and the crematory fee up to 299 lbs. Add urn. Monday - Friday service. If selecting a casket other than listed above, deduct \$895.

Cremation with Memorial Service or Graveside Service

This service includes basic services of funeral director and staff, transfer to mortuary from place of death, memorial ceremony or graveside ceremony, the crematory fee (adults up to 299 lbs.) utility vehicle for death certificates and permits, minimum alternative container. Add urn. Monday - Friday service.

Cremation with 1 Hour Viewing at our Mortuary

This service includes basic services of funeral director and staff, transfer to mortuary from place of death, utility vehicle for death certificates and permits, crematory fee (adults up to 299 lbs.) embalming and 1 hour viewing in our chapel, Monday - Friday during business hours. You will need to select an alternative container for the viewing.
