DIRECT CREMATION

\$2,240 to \$2,500

Charge includes removal of the remains, custodial care, transfer to the crematory and basic services of the funeral director and staff. Minnesota law does not require you to purchase a casket for cremation. If you want to arrange a cremation, you can use a cremation container. A cremation container is a combustible closed container that encases the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or corrugated cardboard and into which a dead human body is placed prior to insertion into a cremation chamber for cremation. The containers we provide are fiberboard, plywood and/or cardboard.

This charge does NOT include any visitation, rites or ceremonies. This charge includes a payment to Riverside Cemetery, Fargo, ND, (\$390) for the crematory fee and Cass County, ND, cremation registration fee (\$10). This charge does NOT include MN county medical examiner fee. Add \$260 for preparation of unembalmed remains for private family viewing.

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial or when refrigeration or use of dry ice is available. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing.

2. **For any “primary service” on SATURDAY, add \$170;**
For any “primary service” on Sunday or holiday, add \$270.
For any “primary service” which begins at 4 PM or later, add \$ 70.
3. All automotive costs are for local trips only. For distances in excess of 40 miles, one way, from our mortuary, an added mileage charge will be made.
4. Any service held in our chapel, after 3 PM, requires a visitation charge.
5. Reception charge includes use of facilities, linen service, disposable cups & plates, and service of attendant.
6. If you choose a funeral service where a rental casket is provided, the casket used for the funeral service may have been used in a previous funeral service. If the casket had been used in a previous funeral service, the interior lining has been replaced or thoroughly cleaned.
