FILING OF LIFE INSURANCE CLAIMS:

Individuals wishing to use the proceeds of a life insurance policy to pay for funeral goods and services, in lieu of paying cash, may elect to have a third party assist you in the filing of a claim on behalf of the beneficiary(ies) of the policy. Please note that if you utilize a third party to file a claim seeking expedited receipt of life insurance proceeds on behalf of a beneficiary, there will be a fee to be paid associated with the filing of such a claim. Any such fees will be deducted from the proceeds of the life insurance policy.

Late Payments - Any amount not paid when due will bear interest & late fees from the due date until paid.

Among the services we offer are church and chapel services or graveside services with interment in a local or out of town cemetery.

In addition we provide many options for those who choose cremation. You may choose a viewing, visitation and traditional services followed by cremation; cremation with a memorial gathering held in our chapel or facility of your choosing, also you may have a private viewing followed by cremation.

Before and after the funeral we provide assistance with pre-planning services for the future. You may either pre-pay the services you desire at today's cost or simply place your wishes on file with us.

Memorial services and gatherings that are away from our facilities we can help you. Many times the family has a number of other things to cope with. There are phone calls to make and friends and out of town guest visiting. Among the many things we do are, delivering and setting up flowers at the service, floral delivery to the residence, assisting the guests with signing the register book and seating, displaying photos and special memory items on our easel and tables, coordinating service plans with the clergy or officiant and coordinating music details with the musicians. Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff\$2895

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

PREPARATION:

Embalming\$699

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Forwarding Remains to Another Funeral Home.....\$2895.00

Our charge includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; a proportionate share of overhead costs; removal of remains; embalming or other preparation of remains, if relevant; and local transportation.

Receiving Remains from Another Funeral Home.....\$2,270

This charge includes temporary shelter of remains, basic services of staff, and transportation of decedent to cemetery or crematory. This charge does not include the use of staff and facilities for visitation, rites and ceremonies, or any other service or merchandise not specifically listed.

Immediate Burial \$2,645 to \$16,640

This charge includes the transfer of decedent to our funeral home, basic services of staff, local transportation to the cemetery, and necessary permits and authorizations. In most areas of the country, state or local law does not require that you buy a container to surround the casket in the grave. However, many cemeteries require that you have such a container so that the grave will not sink in. Either a grave liner or a burial vault will satisfy these requirements.
