Payment Policy

All financial arrangements are made with the Purchaser, and not with the estate of your loved one.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only those items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Basic Services and Overhead of Funeral Director and Staff.....\$1,150

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to: staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family and responsible parties; arrangements of all services requested; preparation and filing of the necessary authorization and permits; recording of vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notice; care of the deceased; and coordination with those providing other portions of the final services. Also included in this charge are the overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building and utility expenses, maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings and administrative expenses.

This fee is for our basic services and overhead and will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Embalming.....\$550
 Except in certain special cases, law does not require embalming. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without outside covering). The containers we provide are a fiberboard container or unfinished wood box.
