

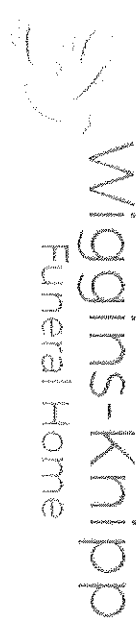

NON-DECLINABLE SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF

Our fee for the services of Funeral Director and staff includes, but is not limited to: Staff to respond to initial request for services; arrangement and preference with family or responsible party; arrangement of funeral; preparation of necessary authorization and permits; preparation and placement of obituary notices; staff assistance prior to, during and following the funeral; including coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, i.e. cemetery, crematory and others. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility, such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses, secretarial and administrative costs, and equipment and inventory expenses.

This Fee For Our Basic Services Will Be Added To The Total Cost Of The Funeral Arrangement You Select (This Fee Is Already Included In Our Charges For Immediate Burials And Forwarding Or Receiving Remains.)

TRANSFER OF REMAINS TO FUNERAL HOME within thirty-mile radius
After normal business hours, weekends, or holidays add \$75.00. If more than one person is required, add an additional \$25.00. (Outside 30-mile radius, \$3.00 per mile) **\$575.00**

EMBALMING
Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with a viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement which does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. **\$675.00**

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body & can be made of fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). Direct cremation services do not include a funeral ceremony.

OTHER SERVICES

FORWARDING REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME **\$2,565.00**
This charge includes transfer of remains to funeral home & to airport, embalming, professional services, & min. transportation container (does not include viewing, funeral ceremony, or airfare).

RECEIVING REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME **\$1,700.00**
This charge includes professional services, transfer of remains to funeral home, & hearse to cemetery (does not include viewing or ceremony).

CASKETS & OUTER BURIAL CONTAINERS
If you arrange for a service that includes a casket, you may select from a group of caskets on display at our facility. Price is determined by composition. The least expensive caskets are particle board, usually with cloth covering. Metal caskets vary in price because of the thickness of the steel, quality of hardware and fabric used for the interior. Semi-precious metals, (i.e. copper or bronze) cost more but offer greater protection for those who seek it. Handwood caskets fall in a medium price range and their price is affected by the amount of hand finishing used to complete the product. **WK (Rev. 09/29/2021)**
