While complete confidentiality cannot be guaranteed, we only share information with individuals or organizations directly involved in the funeral arrangements—such as physicians, insurance providers, Social Security, vital records offices, cemeteries, or clergy. We will only release information to banks or credit card companies after they verify key identifying details. For genealogy requests, limited information may be shared if the requester correctly answers security questions through our online form. We do not provide the name, address, or phone number of the person responsible for arrangements. Instead, we forward the requester's information to that individual. In accordance with Kansas Statute K.S.A. 65-1734, we will only take direction from the legal next of kin when making decisions regarding the disposition of a body. We reserve the right to withhold information at our professional discretion.

## Payment Policy:

At this difficult time, we understand there are many decisions to make. To help prevent any confusion or unexpected financial concerns, we ask that all families take a few moments to review and understand our payment policy. Payment Is Required Before Services Are Provided. All funeral services must be paid in full or verified with express funeral funding prior to the obituary being submitted and/or 24 hours before the day of the service. Cash Advance items: We are happy to assist with coordinating services and forwarding payment to the appropriate parties that require advance payment. These may include:

## Viewing of a Decedent Policy:

Our funeral home offers two options for viewing a loved one prior to cremation or burial. Families may choose a Private Viewing, which includes a brief, non-ceremonial opportunity for the legal next of kin and their immediate descendants (such as a spouse or children) to view the deceased. This time is scheduled prior to cremation, does not include any ceremonial elements, and is limited in attendance. The fee for this service is \$100. For those desiring a more traditional experience, we also offer embalming with public viewing, allowing for a full visitation or funeral service prior to cremation or burial. All viewings are subject to availability and are carried out with the utmost dignity and respect at the discretion of funeral home staff.

#### **BASIC SERVICES OF THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF**

Our basic service charge includes but is not limited to: staff to respond to the initial request for service; arrangement conference with family or responsible party; preparation and filing of necessary certificates and permits; placement of obituary notices; planning of funeral arrangements; and coordination of services with cemetery, crematory, vault company and others as required. Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.
