Choices Related to Payment

To lose someone you love is a devastating human experience. Therefore, it is important to be realistic with respect to funeral expenditures. We do not want your choices to be more than is affordable, nor less than you would like. It is important that the arrangements be in keeping with your wishes and budget.

To provide the finest services possible, we are dependent upon families making payment prior to services and ceremonies. To avoid any possibility of misunderstanding and in order to provide you with financial flexibility, we offer for your convenience the following payment options:

- Cash
- Check
- Money Order/Cashier's Check
- Credit Card
- Application of funds from an Advance Funeral Plan from Beyers Funeral Home
- Assignment of insurance on verified life insurance policies (Policy verification must take place prior to services being provided.)
- Cash Advance Items must be paid for outside of the insurance assignment
- Payments by Estate – We do not file funeral charges against a decedent's estate. All charges must be paid prior to services provided.

If you anticipate a problem or difficulty in meeting these obligations, please discuss the situation with your Funeral Director.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only those items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the Statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

BASIC SERVICES OF THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF 2,925

Staff to respond to initial request for service and arrangement conference, coordinating the details with cemetery, crematory and/or other parties responsible for final disposition of deceased; obtaining death certificate and necessary permits. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains.)

EMBALMING..... 995

Embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Additional fee for embalming remains when an autopsy has been performed 200

Additional fee for the care of the remains where organ donation has been selected 250

OTHER PREPARATION OF THE DECEASED

Sanitary Care (washing and disinfecting remains when there is no embalming) 275

Alternate Care (climate controlled refrigeration facility, up to five days)..... 195

If embalming is declined and final disposition of the deceased is not completed within 24 hours from the time of death, state law requires the remains be placed in a climate controlled facility.

Additional fee, per day, after five days, for the use of the climate controlled facility..... 175

DIRECT CREMATION2,595 to 13,665

Our charge for a direct cremation (without ceremony and merchandise) include basic services of Funeral Director and staff, transfer of deceased to the funeral home, sanitary care, permits and local transportation to the crematory and cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are a corrugated cardboard box or a fiberboard alternative container.

Option D. - Direct cremation with container provided by purchaser..... 2,595

Option E. - Direct cremation with corrugated cardboard box..... 2,695

Option F. - Direct cremation with visual identification by family..... 2,995

(This includes necessary preparation of the remains for a visual identification on a stretcher, for immediate family only)

(Visual Identifications are to be conducted 9:00 – 4:00 Monday thru Friday and are for no longer than 30 minutes)

IMMEDIATE BURIALS.....3,750 to 18,475

Our charge for an immediate burial (without ceremony) includes basic services of Funeral Director and staff, transfer of deceased to the funeral home, transportation to a local cemetery and permits.

Immediate burial with casket provided by purchaser..... 3,750

Immediate burial with alternative cardboard container 3,850

Immediate burial with casket selected from our funeral home (in addition to the cost of casket) 3,750

FORWARDING REMAINS TO ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME 2,945

This charge includes removal of remains, basic services of Funeral Director and staff, embalming, necessary authorizations, and local transportation to airport. This charge does not include viewing, ceremony or merchandise prior to forwarding of the remains.

RECEIVING OF REMAINS FROM ANOTHER FUNERAL HOME 2,945

This charge includes temporary shelter of remains, transportation of remains from airport and necessary services of staff. This charge does not include viewing, ceremony or merchandise.

ANATOMICAL DONATION.....\$ 2,695

This charge includes the Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff, transfer from place of death to funeral home, embalming, and transfer to local receiving medical facility.
