Our charge includes, but is not limited to:

- Shelter and care of deceased prior to ceremonies and services
- Arrangement conference / consultation with the family
- Use of our facilities for the arrangement conference
- Obtaining necessary authorizations and signatures from doctors/hospitals
- Consultation with clergy
- Planning and coordinating flight schedules
- Preparing and filing death certificate
- Preparing and placement of obituary and death notices
- Preparing social security and/or military claims
- Coordinating with others to provide portions of the requested services
- A proportionate share of our basic overhead costs

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

The containers we provide are cardboard. Use of cremation casket or alternative container is required by crematory.
