We understand that for a family who has just experience the loss of a loved one, there can be a myriad of questions, concerns, and needs. It is our sincere goal to answer every question, address every concern, and meet each and every need that your family may have during the course of the upcoming days, weeks, and months.

For many families, the immediate concerns regard what “must be done first” or what is the immediate priority. Below, we have listed a number of items which you may wish to consider and things to remember as you begin to think toward arranging the service for your loved one.

For the newspaper obituary notices, as well as the required legal paperwork, including the death certificate, Social Security and Veterans documents, we will be asking for several items of biographical/vital statistics information. We have compiled a checklist for your convenience as you gather these items.

Checklist For Arrangement Conference

- The full name of the deceased
- Birth Date and Birth Place
- Parents full names, including mother's maiden name
- Social Security Number
- Marital information, including marriage date and place, if applicable
- An additional listing of surviving family members including children, grandchildren, great grandchildren and siblings.
Typically, these are accompanied by the name of the community in which these people reside.
- A listing of deceased immediate family members
- Highest educational level attained (*for death certificate only*)
- Military service information, if applicable
- Occupational and work place history
- Professional, civic and fraternal memberships
- Church Affiliation
- Favorite hobbies or pastimes
- Clothing
- Photographs
- Personal Mementoes (*including but not limited to plaques, trophies, handmade craft items, quilts*)
- DD214 if your loved one was an honorably discharged member of the military
- Insurance/Pension/Retirement paperwork
- Cemetery deed/description

Service Items to Consider

- The date, time and place of the visitation and service
- Clergy or those to bring remarks or a eulogy at the service
- Musicians and/or musical selections for the service
- Pallbearers
- Preferred charities or organizations for memorial contributions
- Newspapers and radios to be contacted with the obituary information.
- Floral arrangements or florist preference
- Specific scripture passages, verses or poems to be used for the service

Additional Notes for Consideration

Clothing: Wearing apparel may be as formal or casual as the family wishes. We kindly ask that you bring underclothing and socks/hose if available. If not, we keep a stock of underclothing that can be used. Shoes are optional, but not required.

Photographs: Many families choose to bring photographs for display at the visitation and funeral service. These may be displayed in a variety of ways. Framed family photos can be brought in the frames and we will arrange these throughout the chapel and entry hall on tables, grouping them as you might in your own home. Loose pictures/snapshots may be arranged by our staff on foam core boards for display in matted collage frames. For those families who desire, we will gladly provide the foam core boards to you so you can arrange the photos as you desire. Additionally, we offer the service of Memorial DVD Slideshow tributes. Pricing information for this service is included.

A. Basic Services of Funeral Director & Staff - \$3,975.00

Our fee for the basic services of Funeral Director and Staff includes, but is not limited to:

- 24 hours per day/365 days per year availability of a funeral director and/or staff members to respond to initial request for services, arrangement conference with the family or responsible party, and coordinating the arrangements for the service, tribute or gathering.
- Staff to advise, assist and recommend appropriate personalization or individualization of the services to commemorate the unique life of your loved one.
- Clerical assistance in the completion of various forms associated with a service, such as Social Security, Veterans Benefits, and insurance documentation.
- Obtaining and recording biographical information and statistical data.
- Preparation and transmission of obituary notice(s)/tribute(s) in newspaper(s).
- Death certificate preparation, filing and securing the necessary permits, authorizations, consents and assignments.
- Initial caretaking and sheltering of the deceased.
- Coordination with those providing other services, such as a hospital, nursing facility, assisted/supportive living, home/hospice facility, doctor's office, medical examiner/coroner's office, cemetery, vault company, crematory, clergy/celebrant, organist, pianist, vocalist and others involved in the services and final disposition/memorialization.

B. Embalming - \$1,250.00

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as a direct cremation or immediate burial. It is the policy of Bailey Funeral Home to require embalming for all arrangements that involve a public viewing.

C. Other preparation of the Body (Cosmetology, dressing, and casketing of remains) - \$425.00

Care for un-embalmed remains (bathing and disinfection) - \$175.00

D. Cremation Fee - \$650.00

This fee does not include charges for a viewing/visitation (other than a private family identification, as shown above), services or ceremonies. Nor, does it include the cost of a Coroner's Permit to Cremate (required in the State of Illinois), and other cash advanced items, including IL sales tax (calculated at 7.75%) on any merchandise provided (including the Alternative Container). Additionally, a cremation urn is not included in this option but may be purchased separately. Cremated remains will be returned to the family in a temporary cremation container, as provided by the crematory. Bailey Funeral Home will, however, place cremated remains in urns, keepsake urns and keepsake jewelry as provided by the family, when purchased through a third-party provider or handcrafted by the family. There is no charge for this service.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of material like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are made of a wooden base with a fiberboard covering.

Death Certificates: How Many Will I Need?

Some businesses and agencies may accept a photo copy of the death certificate instead of a certified copy.

- Life Insurance – You will need one for each life insurance company.
- Banks, Credit Card Companies / Lenders – You will need one for each, especially if the accounts are in the deceased name only.
- Stocks – You will need one for each company whether held individually or jointly. If they were held by the broker then you will need one for each individual broker.
- Bonds – You will need one for each US Saving Bond. Bonds can be reissued to new owners. If you have corporate bonds you will need one for each company.
- Real Estate – You will need one for each county in which each piece of property is owned.
- Secretary of State – You will need one which may be used for automobile, boat or mobile home.
- IRA's / CD's – You will need one for each financial institution where the funds are located.
- Pension – You will need one for each pension fund.
- Health and Dental Insurance – You may need one if the insurance is employer provided.
- Current Pay/Vacation Pay – You may need one if deceased was still actively employed.
- Retirement Plans – You will need one for each account.
- Federal Tax/State Tax/Local Tax – You will need one for each.
- Probate – if there is to be a Probate of the deceased estate than you will need at least 5.
- Social Security – You will need one if you will be receiving benefits, but may need one anyway.
- Medicare or Medical – You will need one for each if you are receiving benefits from them.
- Employer (HR Department) – For unpaid wages, vacation, or group benefits
- Tax Agencies – Federal, state, and possibly local (e.g., IRS, Franchise Tax Board)
- Probate Court – 3–5 certified copies often required for estate proceedings
- Veterans Affairs (if applicable) – For military funeral benefits or VA pensions
- Utility Companies – May request one for account closure or name transfer
- Safe Deposit Box Access – Banks may require one to grant access
