These prices are effective as of <u>March 1, 2023</u> and are subject to change without notice.

Prior to drafting a contract for goods or services, the responsible party or the decedent's survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any preneed agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items that you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF:

This is a basic fee that we charge every family for our professional expertise in assisting them with their preferences. It includes a proportionate share of the taxes, licenses, utilities and business expenses required to serve the public. Coordination of arrangements with clergy, musicians, florists, motor escorts, cemetery or crematory, fraternal organizations, common carriers and other funeral service providers. Assistance with applying for benefits from all county, state or federal agencies. Personnel available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to respond to initial call. This charge also includes, but is not limited to, consultation with family, administrative and clerical services, preparation of the death certificate for certification by the attending physician or coroner and filing the death certificate with the appropriate government agencies. There will be a charge for each service requested or required. This fee for our services will be added to the total cost of the arrangements you select. This fee is included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains.

Embalming – complete preparation, including sanitary care and necessary supplies for procedure.

(Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary,

however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with a viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.)

DIRECT CREMATION: \$950

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative Containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are made of wood, fiberboard and other composition materials.

Our charge (without ceremony) includes refrigeration, sanitary-care bathing and minimum services of staff. It does not include crematory Fees, transportation to and from the crematory, alternative container, urn, inurnment or Scattering fees.

PROTECTIVE: these casket manufacturers make no claim that the casket will completely resist the entry of gravesite elements. They may be constructed of bronze, copper, ceramic, stainless. steel and varying gauges of steel.

NON-PROTECTIVE: These caskets are not designed to resist the entry of gravesite elements. They may be constructed of steel, hardwood or wood products covered with fabric.

The Insurance Assignment Transaction Fee covers the work of the office staff in verifying insurance policies, processing claim forms and any other necessary paperwork required by the insurance company and follow up on submitted claims. In addition to the Insurance Assignment Transaction Fee, a 1.5% monthly service charge will be charged on any unpaid balance after 90 days.

Crematories

We will use any crematory you wish. When using a crematory outside Riverside, transportation charges may be slightly higher. All local transportation fees of \$1.50 per mile over 25 miles shall apply. All fees regarding crematory, cemetery interment, scattering of ashes, shipping, county or state fees shall be listed separately.
