

Explanation of Services

Professional & Staff Services – fall into the following categories

Co-ordinating activities, rites, ceremonies \$550

- Professional consultation with licensed personnel, including, but not limited to, expert advice on options to meet your needs.

- Co-ordination of all activities, rites and ceremonies, before, during and after they have been provided, including services and supplies provided by us, as well as those provided by third party suppliers, such as cemetery, crematory and death notices. \$985

Documentation – permits, forms, etc. \$285

- Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate for cremation and/or cemetery record.
- Provision of 10 Proofs of Death issued by Haycock-Cavanagh (our proofs of death are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes, but sometimes a provincial "Death Certificate" will be necessary and is available from the Office of the Registrar General)

Transport remains – initial or additional (additional fees apply beyond specified km below) \$295

- Transportation of the remains from one place to another, for example the hospital to the business, or the business to the cemetery or crematorium, a charge applies for each transportation request
 - Using a funeral coach or hearse to cemetery within 20km or
 - Using an unmarked van within 50km

Basic preparation of remains (requires Facilities for preparation/embalming/shelter) \$220

- The preparation of the body for placement into the casket, including but not limited to bathing, dressing and the setting of facial features for identification or viewing without embalming.

Embalming of remains (This charge is in addition to the basic preparation of remains) \$400

- Embalming is the process of replacing blood and bodily fluids with chemical preservatives. It is a process of sanitation, restoration and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required, but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation or disposition of the deceased. Our professional funeral directors will make a recommendation based on the condition of the body and expected service needs.

Facilities for preparation/embalming/shelter

- Facilities used to prepare, embalm and shelter the body \$250

Staff services for initial ceremony or visitation

\$700

- Staff to coordinate set-up and oversee the initial ceremony or visitation for up to 3 hours on weekdays. Saturdays (+\$250) and Holidays (+\$500) are extra.

Facilities for initial ceremony or visitation (requires Staff services for initial ceremony)

\$700

- Designated facilities used for the ceremony or visitation for up to 3 hours or the set up involved with a remote location for the funeral.

Staff services for subsequent ceremony or visitation

\$300

- Staff to coordinate and oversee a 2nd or 3rd period of ceremony or visitation for a period up to 4 hours or the oversight required for off premises visiting.

Facilities for subsequent ceremony or visitation

\$300

(requires Staff services for subsequent ceremony or visitation)

Designated facilities used for ceremony/visitation for a period up to 4 hours OR the equipment for visitation at a remote location.

Professional restorative procedures	\$	50
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In some circumstances, additional restorative efforts beyond those captured in the standard embalming procedure are necessary to enhance the appearance of the deceased. In such cases, the funeral director will discuss the available options and their cost. Professional restorative procedures will be charged per hour. 		
Scattering of cremated remains	\$	500
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will scatter cremated remains in accordance with Ontario and municipal laws and by-laws on land. Fees for scattering from a plane or boat will be in addition to this charge and will be discussed upon request. 		

Disbursements

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by us. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered into. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements.

Coroner's fee – this is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

\$75

Clergy honorarium – this is an amount paid to the clergy for their services. In some cases the amount is set by the clergy, in others it is an amount to be determined by you.

Funeral Home Supplied Funeral Celebrant – this is an amount paid directly to the staff member acting as the Funeral Celebrant to lead services. \$75.00

Newspaper or radio notices – these are charges for death notices placed in newspapers or radio or other media outlets.

Courier Press \$50 - 100 (with photo)

Local Daily publications \$150 - \$300 (without photo, charged by the # of lines)

Radio \$45

Municipal death registration fee – this is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may vary. For Chatham-Kent as of Feb 1, 2024 = \$59.55

Bereavement Authority of Ontario Consumer Protection Fee = \$30.00

Rental of Grass & Lowering Device at the Cemetery. Provided by a vault company

With a vault \$107.00

Saturday Surcharge Fee \$200.00

Sundays and Holidays overtime fee \$600.00

Cemetery fees

Opening & closing of the grave fees vary from cemetery to cemetery.

Some cemeteries have Saturday, holiday and late in the day overtime fees.

Catering or Food Costs:

When We Cater – Soup & Sandwich: Choice of Gourmet Soup & Buns, Premium Meats & Cheeses, Lettuce, Tomatoes, Fruit Tray, Vegetable Tray, Pickle Tray, Soft Drinks, Coffee, Tea and Desert usually costs \$12-\$15 per person. Payment, financing and funding

We are proud to offer various payment, funding and financing options to our clients.

A deposit of 20% of the funeral costs is required before services and merchandise are provided.

Payment

Unless otherwise specified, payment is due within 30 days of signing the contract. Payment may be made by cash, cheque, bank draft or E-Transfer. Payment plans are also available to meet most budgets. Financing charges apply to payment plans. Beyond the allotted time, interest will be charged at a rate of 1.5%, which is equivalent to 18% per annum (APR).

If you are prepaying for services or supplies, pre-authorized chequing is also available.

Financing

Our payment plans give you the option of making payments over time. We offer a competitive financing program, administration fees and interest rates.

Funding

For your convenience, we offer two funding options when prepaying services or supplies. When prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today and the money will be used to pay for the services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death.

Trust: You may pay the money directly to us and we will place it in trust, where it will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered) or the contract is cancelled.

Insurance: You may purchase an insurance contract where the proceeds of the insurance contract will be used to pay for the services or supplies at the time they are delivered or the contract is cancelled. This is a convenient way to make payments over a period of time.

Disbursements: Due to the new funeral act, we are no longer allowed to accept prepayment for cemetery or cremation fees. By law, these fees can only be paid at the time of need.
