However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Professional Services

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff

\$1,200.00

Our fee for the services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family or responsible party; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notices; staff assistance prior to, during and following the funeral, including coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g. cemetery, crematory and others. Also included in these charges are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses, secretarial and administrative costs, and equipment and inventory costs.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Embalming

\$900.00

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Our services include coordinating the memorial service arrangements, supervision of the memorial service, and staff to attend the service in chapel or another location.

Director & Staff for Graveside Service

Our services include accompaniment of remains to cemetery, supervision of graveside service, and staff to attend service.

Our charge for an immediate burial, without any attendant rites or ceremonies, includes removal and shelter of remains, local transportation to the cemetery, necessary services of staff, and authorizations. (Does not include visitation, rites or ceremonies, outer burial container or opening and closing of grave.) Due to no embalming, to protect the public health, viewing is limited to family identification.

Direct Cremation

Our charge for a direct cremation without any attendant rites or ceremonies includes removal of remains, local transportation to crematory, necessary services of staff, and authorizations. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are:

Outer Burial Container Price List – all prices exclude sales tax and effective August 15, 2026.

Please note in the state of Georgia, no state or local laws require you to buy an outer burial container to enclose the casket in the grave. However, public, private or perpetual care cemeteries are allowed to request you to have such a container so that the grave will not sink. All vaults listed below will satisfy such requirements.

Note: Franklin Memorial Gardens—South and North, Nancy Hart Memorial Park, Danielsville Memorial Park, and all other perpetual-care cemeteries set their own opening and closing fees. Most of these cemeteries will require that the fees be taken care of and an interment authorization be signed directly with one of their representatives prior to interment.

Newspaper Notices- most (not all) local papers offer a free notice that gives basic information about the decedent (name, date of death, service information), or a paid notice that lists the full obituary. The price of a paid notice is based on word count and per column inch. These prices are emailed to us weekly and will be added to the Funeral Goods and Services contract once we receive the final price.

Terms of Payment: payment is expected when services are rendered

- **Cash or Check**
- **Credit Card** – 3.5% processing fee will be included (all major credit cards accepted)
- **Life Insurance Assignment** - Because life insurance claims can take several weeks or months to process, we are unable to delay payment of funeral expenses while waiting for insurance proceeds. When life insurance is used to pay for funeral expenses, the policy will be verified through Top Tier Funeral Funding, our third-party funding provider. Once approved, they work directly with the insurance company and typically provide payment to the funeral home within 48 hours. A 3.5% processing fee, based on the total funeral charges, applies when using this service. To verify the policy, we will need: name of the life insurance company, policy or contract number, and the name(s) of the beneficiary(ies). If the primary beneficiary is deceased, a copy of their death certificate and the signatures of the legal next of kin will be required to complete the necessary estate paperwork. If the policy cannot be verified, it cannot be accepted as payment. To avoid the 3.5% processing fee: Funeral expenses must be paid in full at the time of arrangements. We will assist with filing the insurance claim, and the insurance company will send the proceeds directly to the policy beneficiary.

Note: We understand that every family's situation is different. If you are experiencing financial hardship or have special circumstances, please speak with the funeral director before the arrangement conference so we can discuss alternative arrangements.
