A Life Celebration Service is an individualized tribute to reflect the personality and the life story of your loved one. Working closely with the family, a trained Celebrant will gather "The Story" of your loved one, customize a tribute of music, poetry, scripture and prayer or anything that would be meaningful to your family. Family participation is welcomed. We wish this celebration of your loved one's life to be the first step in your journey in the healing process.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. **However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead.** If legal or other requirements mean you must buy an item you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected. Nothing the funeral director or anyone else may say should be taken as modifying or differing from the goods and services you selected as shown on that agreement.

The package or individually selected prices shown DO NOT include a casket, outer burial container/vault, clothing, any other merchandise or cash advances that you might ask us to buy for you (such as cemetery charges, honorariums, flowers, death certificates or newspaper notices), unless they are shown as included in a package price. The prices for these items, if selected, will be shown on your bill or statement describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Traditional Services Packages For Our Burial or Cremation Families

1. **Traditional Funeral Service with Services in Your Church or Burial in another cemetery** \$ 6,250
This package includes all the usual items for a complete funeral, which are: services of the funeral director and staff, transfer of remains to the funeral home within a 20 mile radius, embalming, other preparation of the deceased, use of the facilities and staff for one or two days of visitation and funeral ceremony, a visitors' register book, 100 standard prayer cards (deluxe custom prayer cards are an additional charge), 50 thank you cards, and a standard cross or crucifix for inside the casket and attention to all the details including filing of forms with government offices, preparation of newspaper notices and handling floral tributes. Also included is the funeral coach (hearse) and lead car necessary to leave the grounds whether going to church and back to Jefferson Memorial or from our facility to another cemetery.
2. **Traditional Funeral with Services and Interment within Jefferson Memorial** \$5,145
This plan is the same as package 1 except, because you are staying on the premises, a hearse (\$435), lead car (\$185) and staff for services at church or another facility (\$485) are not required. Therefore, \$1,105 for those items has been deducted.
3. **A Life Celebration Traditional Viewing Service** \$ 5,640
This plan includes a Life Celebration Service in our Chapel conducted by a Certified Celebrant. This plan includes all the usual items for a complete funeral which are listed in package 1 above while removing those items not required when having services in our chapel as explained in package 2.

Provisions for Payment are Due at the Time of Arrangements

The loss of someone close to you is traumatic and can impact your judgement. We understand your desire to celebrate a life well lived and will assist in arranging an appropriate service to meet your needs. You must also be realistic in respect to funeral expenditures so that arrangements are in keeping with your family's wishes and budget. If you have a time payment contract with Jefferson, the payments will be accelerated to pay off any item of merchandise or service needed for this arrangement. Provisions for payment are due at the time of arrangements. We accept: Cash, Check, Debit Card, Visa, MasterCard, Discover and Insurance Assignment of a verifiable policy.

Memorialization - Because Everyone Deserves To Be Remembered

Memorialization is having a place to visit where the mortal remains of someone important to us are interred and will be visited and remembered. Throughout human history, memorialization of the dead has been a key component of every culture. Cremation, like traditional burial, should not be considered an end but the beginning of the process to create a lasting tribute and a place of honor for the present generation to tell your story to the next generation and for all to pay their respects. Psychologists say that remembrance practices, from the funeral or memorial service to providing a permanent memorialization, serve an important emotional function for survivors by helping to bring closure and allowing the healing process to begin. Providing a permanent resting place for the deceased is a dignified treatment for a loved one's mortal remains, and fulfills the natural human desire for memorialization, because everyone deserves to be remembered.

Interment of cremated remains in a sepulture in our affiliate, Jefferson Memorial Cemetery \$ 980 to \$ 13,057

Placement of cremated remains in a private niche, grave or in a communal interment arrangement are available. You will need to consult with our licensed cemetery real estate agent to obtain specific information about the choices offered.

LEGAL NOTICE REGARDING A CREMATION: The cremation cannot take place until all required authorizations are signed, a death certificate is secured and filed, a cremation permit is issued, Coroner's authorization received and 24 hours have elapsed.

4. Basic Cremation (Security Deposit Required) \$ 3,165 to \$ 3,370

Called Direct Cremation by the FTC: includes local transfer and limited preparation of the deceased for the visual identification only (no embalming), refrigeration, transportation to crematory, basic services of funeral director and staff, securing all necessary signatures and authorizations, basic use of funeral home and delivery of the cremated remains to the place of burial (within 20 miles) or the next of kin and cremation fee. Not included: visitation, memorial services, hearse, limousine, cash advances, or any merchandise you may choose. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body, and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without outside covering). The containers we provide are made of fiberboard.

5. Basic Cremation with a Memorial Service in Funeral Home Chapel \$4,235

This plan includes use of the funeral home chapel, facilities and staff for a memorial service, the Register book (\$105) and a package of up to 100 standard prayer cards (\$90) and 50 thank you cards (\$50) and all the items listed in Package 4 above.

6. Basic Cremation with a Memorial Service at another facility such as a Church or The National Cemetery \$4,420

This plan includes the staff and lead car to have a Memorial Service at another facility and all the items listed in Package 4 and Package 5 above.

CORONER AUTHORIZATION FEE: The fee charged by the Coroner's Office for authorizing cremation will be added as a cash advance to each service involving cremation. (this fee is subject to change at any time by the County Coroner) **\$50**

Cremation Fee (already added to packages 4,5,6) \$700

A Security Deposit of \$670 will be added to ALL Cremation Services that do not include some form of burial that is pre-paid.

The full amount of the deposit shall be refunded within 30 days after the funeral bill is paid and the remains are picked up or interred, provided this occurs no later than 45 days from the date of the cremation. In the unlikely event that the cremated remains are abandoned to the funeral home, the deposit will be used to pay for the interment of the remains in a simple niche or communal sepulture or ossuary without a name plate.

Some Information About Scattering: Though occasionally done, the practice of scattering human remains can present difficulties for your survivors. Some people may find it hard to simply pour the mortal remains of a loved one out onto the ground or into the sea. Another difficulty with scattering can occur when the remains are disposed of in an anonymous, unmarked or public place. Access to the area may be restricted for some reason in the future, undeveloped land may be developed or any of a host of other conditions may arise that could make it difficult for your survivors to visit the site to remember you. Once scattered, cremated remains cannot be collected back.

Price Guarantee Option

The prices shown herein are applicable to services delivered within 90 days of the execution of the Statement of Goods and Services. To guarantee the price of any of the above packages for a Pre-Arrangement add fifteen percent (15%) to the itemized or package price. The price guarantee is only for services delivered by Jefferson Memorial Funeral Home or Jefferson Memorial Crematory and only when funded via an insurance policy sold by our affiliate Jefferson Memorial Cemetery. There is NO Price Guarantee for any cash advances shown on the Statement of Goods & Services even if money has been set aside to pay for or help offset the cost of those outside services when purchases are required some time in the future.

The Purchaser will be refunded or credited the difference of a package that has been fully pre-paid and guaranteed by paying this extra amount if on the day of delivery the price on the then current GPL for the same services is less than the purchaser previously paid.

7. Immediate Burial \$ 2,845 to \$ 3,840

Includes local transfer and preparation of the deceased for identification (no embalming), refrigeration, basic services of funeral director and staff, securing all necessary signatures, basic use of facilities and transportation to Jefferson Memorial Cemetery. Not included: transportation to another local cemetery, visitation, funeral ceremony or memorial service, cash advances or any merchandise you may desire. The minimum casket provided is made of corrugated cardboard. [K Flair or Comparable]

Funeral Home Services, Commodities and Facilities Available Individually.

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff, and overhead:\$1,650

Our professional service charge includes, but is not limited to, counseling and availability on a twenty-four hour basis, consultation with family, and clergy, assistance of staff in all phases of arrangements, obtaining and preparing all necessary notices, consents, authorizations, certificates and permits, care and arrangement of flowers, coordinating with those providing other portions of the funeral (e.g. cemetery, crematory, clergy, etc.)

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for the direct cremation, immediate burials and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Transfer of remains to funeral home: (within 20 mile radius)\$375

Embalming:\$740

Embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

8. Forwarding remains to another Funeral Home:

Includes local transfer of remains, basic services of funeral director and staff, embalming, discussion and implementation of desired arrangements, preparing, securing all necessary signatures and authorizations of documentation, basic use of facilities, vehicle for local use and a shipping case of fiberboard or composition material. Not included: shipping charges, visitation, funeral coach (hearse), limousine, cash advances, any merchandise you may choose.....\$3,575

9. Receiving remains from another Funeral Home:

Includes basic services of funeral director and staff, temporary shelter of deceased, basic use of facilities, securing permits, transportation to funeral home and to Jefferson Memorial Cemetery. Not included: transportation to another local cemetery, hearse, limousine, cash advances, any merchandise you may choose \$2,310

We Offer Green Burial

Green burial is as natural as possible in all respects. Special bio-degradable embalming fluids permit time to say goodbye, interment is in a bio-degradable casket or a fiberboard alternative container in a shroud or favorite blanket. No vault or traditional tombstone or marker is used. The burial site is a natural setting allowing growth of trees, shrubs and wild flowers, not manicured grass that require pesticides and herbicides to control nature. Instead, the cemetery allows nature to take its course.
