#### Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff

Also included in this fee are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses, administration and clerical costs and equipment and inventory expenses. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the funeral arrangements you select.

#### Embalming

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements such as funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as cremation or immediate burial.
