■ Payment Policy

Please take the time to read our payment policy. Know that we wish to make this time of sorrow as comfortable for you as possible. If you have any questions, please ask.

The Funeral Purchase Contract must be signed by the purchaser at the conclusion of arranging services. A deposit of 25% of the contract total is due at the conclusion of arrangements. Additional items estimated such as obituary notices, flowers, etc. will be adjusted and due at the completion of services.

Other payment options must be discussed and agreed to by the funeral director when signing the contract. The total balance is due at the completion of funeral services.

If more than one family member will be responsible for payment, we ask that they sign our contract jointly and severally. However, we request that one person represent the family and look to the other members for reimbursement.

A penalty of 18% per annum for unanticipated late payment will be charged to the remaining balance due 30 days from the date of the signed contract. Purchaser(s) agrees to pay reasonable attorney's court costs and other costs of collection if incurred in the collection of this debt.

Loudoun Funeral Chapel does accept insurance assignments with approval of valid funds and assignment from any and all beneficiaries. We will file the insurance claim for \$150.00.

The terms and conditions of this assignment are available when this option is exercised. This enables both parties to receive funds within an expedited amount of time.

We do not bill the Estate of the Deceased. Under circumstances where the deceased's estate must stand the burden of paying funeral expenses, we ask that either a personal representative or the person listed on the funeral purchase contract pay funeral expenses and file their claim for reimbursement.

International and Out-of-State Shipping – Loudoun Funeral Chapel requires that all funeral home charges and cash advances be paid in full prior to shipping of the human remains.

We accept the following forms of payment: Cash, Certified Check, Personal Check, Verified/Assignable Insurance Benefits, Major Credit Cards.

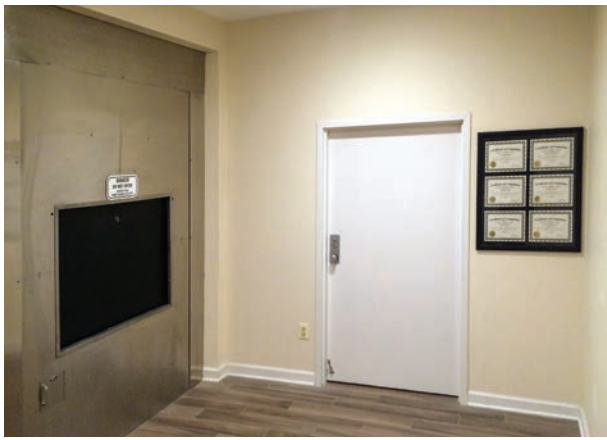

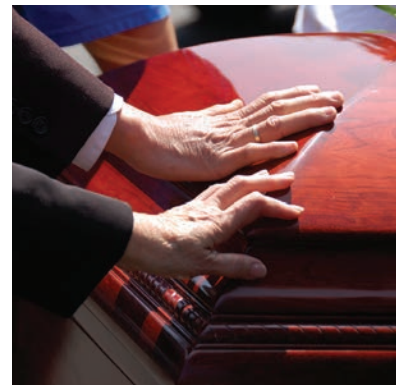
Traditional Visitation

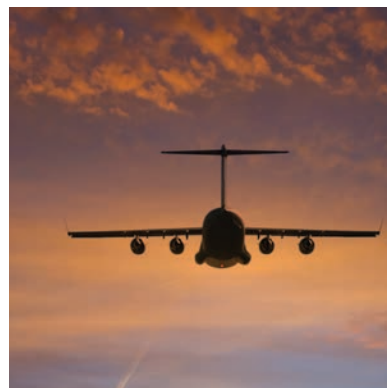

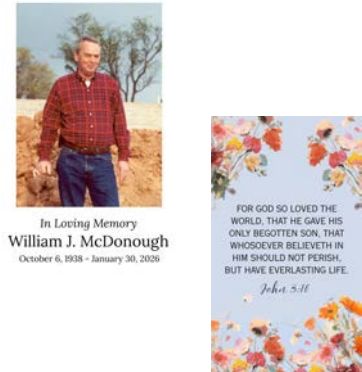

UNDERSTANDING GRIEF & LOSS

Grief is a necessary part of healing after the loss of a loved one. Your feelings when grieving will be normal and natural. Other people will also be feeling just as you do.



Basic Facts About Grief

Here are several important things to remember if you are confronting grief or consoling someone else who grieves:

- Grief is an unavoidable process that must be experienced on the road to recovery.
- Grief is cumulative.
- Verbal expression speeds the grieving process.
- Grieving people do not need advice.
- The quiet, reassuring presence of a friend can be helpful during each stage of grief.
- People usually die in character and in the way they lived.
- Uncomplicated grief can be lengthy and intense.
- There is no right or wrong way to grieve.

The Stages of Grief

Each person tends to experience distinct stages when grieving any major loss. He or she will also often drift in and out of these stages for an indefinite period.

1. **SHOCK AND DENIAL.** The real and the unreal collide. It's hard to believe the person is gone. Shock and denial are the body's defense mechanisms against an abrupt and stressful change.
2. **DISORGANIZATION.** People often become disorganized while working through their grief. They might lose or misplace things, or have trouble remembering names. Disorganization is one way the mind protects itself from a traumatic event.
3. **ANGER.** The bereaved will be angry: at the doctors, the hospital, the car in the accident or even the person who "abandoned" other people by dying. This anger is often followed by volatile emotions such as laughter and despair in the space of a minute.

4. **GUILT.** Someone who grieves might blame him- or herself for things said or done in the past. He or she may even feel responsible somehow for the loss. This is a natural process of healing that will be overcome.
5. **PERIODS OF DEPRESSION.** Anniversaries and holidays such as Christmas can be particularly challenging.
6. **PERIOD OF RELIEF.** Feelings get better, and a belief that “I will pull through” sets in.
7. **FEELING OF RESOLUTION.** A person is revitalized and ready to return to the world. Life moves on without the same constant struggle over the loss. Relationships and contacts are renewed.

Grief never goes away, but it can be managed back to a point of much lesser pain. One may sometimes regress into grief, but each instance will become easier to handle.

It is important to progress through all of grief’s stages. Sooner or later, a person must cope: He or she can’t simply refuse to accept grief and then forget about it. Denial only postpones the pain. True, thorough healing requires every step to recovery.

Each one of us must cope with the loss of a loved one in our own way, on our own terms.

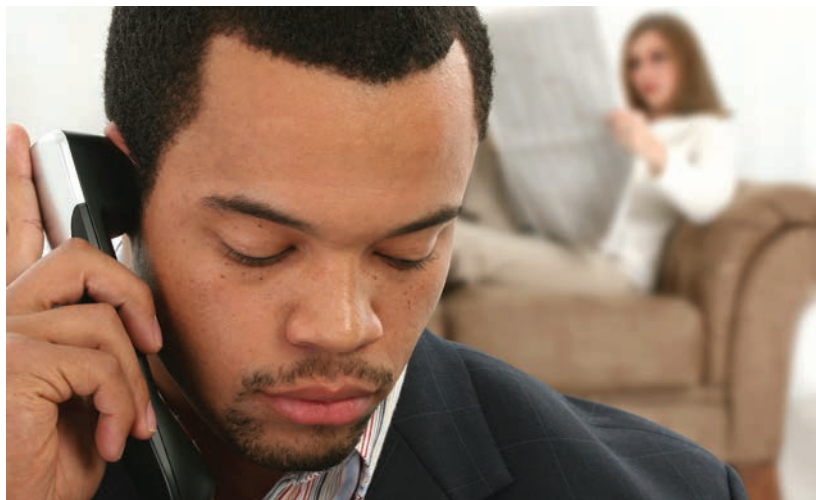

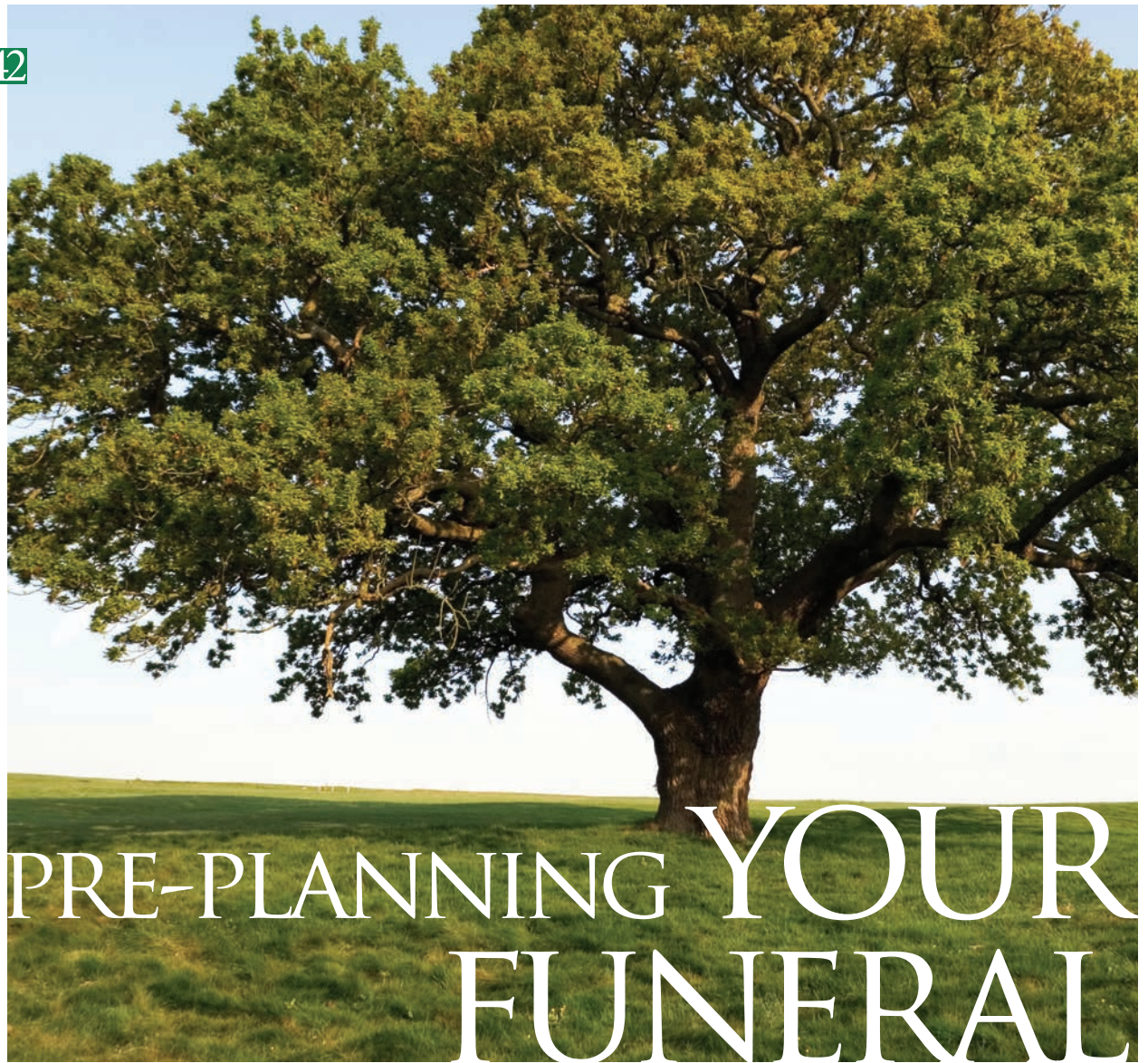

VETERANS BURIAL BENEFITS

For Burial in a National Cemetery

<http://www.cem.va.gov/>

Burial benefits available include a grave site in any of the 131 national cemeteries with available space, opening and closing of the grave, perpetual care, a government headstone or marker, a burial flag, and a Presidential Memorial Certificate, at no cost to the family.

Burial benefits available for spouses and dependents buried in a national cemetery include burial with the Veteran, perpetual care, and their name and date of birth and death will be inscribed on the Veteran's headstone, at no cost to the family. Eligible spouses and dependents may be buried, even if they predecease the Veteran.

Cremated remains are buried or interred in national cemeteries in the same manner and with the same honors as casketed remains.

For Burial in a Private Cemetery

Burial benefits available for Veterans buried in a private cemetery may include a government headstone or marker, a burial flag, and a Presidential Memorial Certificate, at no cost to the family. There are no VA benefits available to spouses and dependents buried in a private cemetery.

Arlington National Cemetery

Eligibility for in-ground burial at Arlington National Cemetery is the most stringent of all U.S. national cemeteries. However, most veterans, who have at least one day of active service, other than training and Honorable Discharge, are eligible for above-ground interment.

Standard Military Honors

Include a casket team (body bearers / pallbearers), firing party, bugler and military chaplain

Full Military Honors

Commissioned and warrant officers interred/interred at Arlington National Cemetery will receive honors provided by the decedent's branch of service.

Full military honors include a casket team (body bearers/pall bearers), firing party, bugler, escort platoon (size varies according to the rank of the deceased), military band, the caisson and military chaplain.
